The collaboration between the two companies Principio Attivo Teatro and La Luna nel letto, both of which pay close attention to the use of body language on stage, leads the audience into an imaginary word free from certain answers to difficult questions. Two clowns clash with one another, much like





humans and material dimensions clash in life and also pleasure and duty, internal and external time that always keeps moving.

The artists group is inspired by the language used in the silent movies of Fritz Lang, Buster Keaton, and Charlie Chaplin to communicate such a complex theme even to the youngest audience. The search for happiness finds its way through laughter and poetry...
